Eva Grayzel, a nationally recognized Master Storyteller and performance artist, was diagnosed at age 33 with stage IV oral cancer and given a 15% chance of survival. After regaining her deep vibrant voice, Eva applied her stage skills to communicate the depth of her experience in a unique and powerful way. For over a decade, Eva has captivated dental professionals worldwide using her story as a catalyst for change. She performed "Tongue-Tied" Off-Broadway in New York City to a sold-out audience. A champion for early detection, Eva founded the Six-Step Screening™ oral cancer awareness campaign. Eva is the author of two children's books, Mr. C Plays Hide and Seek and Mr. C the Globetrotter.

One American dies every hour of every day from oral cancer. Eva Grayzel came close to being the one in this statistic. The riveting details of Eva's delayed diagnosis stimulate thinking about enhanced patient care and education. Eloquent and engaging, Eva reveals the devastating effects of treatment, driving listeners to take responsibility for early intervention. Putting a face to the disease, Eva inspires audiences with her firsthand account of hardships unanticipated and overcome; courage unknown and discovered; a mother's love tested and triumphant. Eva speaks from heart to heart, making her memorable message a catalyst for change. Audiences don't just hear her story, they experience it.

# Exploring the oral microbiome-How microbes actually create disease

Recent discoveries about polymicrobial biofilms are both disturbing and thought provoking. Dental diseases are not classic infections. New molecular techniques demonstrate caries and periodontal disease are manifestations of dramatic, sustained shifts in microbial ecology that overwhelm the host immune system. Microbes, once thought to be key players may play a minor role, while relatively unknown species, or even entire microbial communities, can increase virulence, sustain acid production, enhance inflammation and continue tissue destruction. Homeostasis still remains the ultimate goal. New disease concepts are changing the conversation and challenging how dental disease is viewed today.
